Founded in 1972, The Dance Archive (TDA) is a special collecting area within the University of Denver's Special Collections and Archive. TDA is an extensive teaching and learning resource and repository of dance and performing arts history and culture encompassing Colorado and the American West. TDA documents, preserves, recognizes, and sponsors significant contributions supporting dance in our region.

Legends of Dance

The Legends of Dance program began in 2004 after the sudden passing of Freidann Parker, co-creator of Colorado Ballet.

Wanting to capture the history of dance in the region, The Dance Archive has honored 4 to 6 individuals or organizations each year since 2004 who have made a significant impact on dance in Colorado.

The Dance Archive holds over 100 oral history interviews with Legends of Dance honorees. These interviews are available for future dancers, educators, anyone and everyone.

In 2022, Legends of Dance expanded to include dance performances from past honorees and/or their companies. 2024 marked 20 years of honoring dance change makers in the region.
